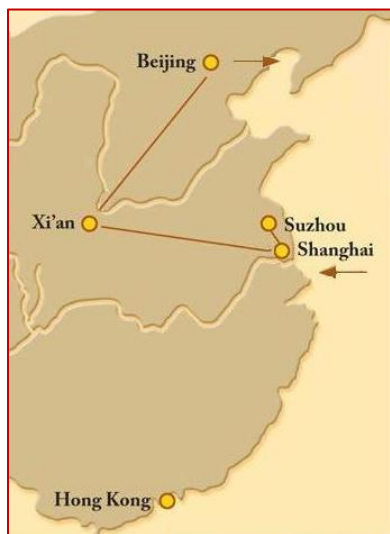

Itinerary Summary:

- Day 1** Arrive in Shanghai
- Day 2** **Shanghai:** Take a city tour of Shanghai starting with Jade Buddha Temple and also spend time visiting the exhibits at the world famous Shanghai Museum. Visit the Oriental Pearl TV Tower and take a Huangpu River Cruise after dinner.
- Day 3** **Shanghai-Suzhou-Shanghai:** Board a motor coach to Suzhou, nicknamed "Venice of the East" and the "Garden City". The city tour includes visit to the Humble Administrator's Garden, Grand Canal boat ride, Silk Embroidery Institute & Pan Men City Gate. Back to Shanghai.
- Day 4** **Shanghai:** Visit the Yu Garden, considered to be one of the four great Chinese gardens. Shop in Shanghai Bazaar. Visit the Bund and Nanjing Road. This evening attend the world renowned performance of Chinese Acrobatics.
- Day 5** **Shanghai - Xian:** Take the world's fastest train "The Maglev" (travelling at 263 mph) to the Airport. Morning flight to Xian. Take a half day city tour visiting the Big Wild Goose Pagoda, City Wall and Bell Tower.
- Day 6** **Xian:** The highlight of visit to Xian is the life-sized Terra Cotta Army of Qin Shin Huang. Later visit the Shaanxi Museum. Tonight enjoy the world famous Tang Dynasty Dinner Show.
- Day 7** **Xian - Beijing:** Morning flight to Beijing, one of China's largest & modern cities and the capital.
- Day 8** **Beijing:** Today stop at the Temple of Heaven for a visit. Also visit an elegant and ancient temple known as the Yonghe Lamasery, the most perfectly preserved lamasery in China. In the afternoon visit the local shops.
- Day 9** **Beijing:** Visit the feature attraction, the 4000 mile long Great Wall followed by a visit to the Ming Tomb Museum. Also enjoy the famous "Legend of Kung Fu" show.
- Day 10** **Beijing:** Guided full day city tour of Tiananmen Square and the Forbidden City. End the day's tour at the Summer Palace, the Emperor's place of respite.
- Day 11** **Depart Beijing:** Transfer from hotel to airport to board the international flight to New York.
